Prizes

Many of the named prizes were generously presented by, or in memory of, Old Blundellians, Masters, Governors and Benefactors. Over the years, some have been adapted to reflect changing mores. Descriptions of some of these prizes are given below:

The Arnold Cup

This cup is awarded to the most successful Blundell's team of the year. It is donated by the Shilston Family in memory of their daughter Susan Arnold, late wife of Blundell's School Governor Nigel Arnold.

The Clarissa Slade Memorial Prize

Presented to a senior pupil who has contributed in a generous and self-effacing way to all areas of School life, without expectation of reward. Through this prize, we warmly remember Clarissa Slade who tragically died whilst at University, aged 21, this year (2018). Clarissa was a hugely generous young woman. She loved Blundell's, and Politics and Drama in particular. She triumphed over significant personal challenges that she faced and is greatly missed by us all.

The Whitehead Cup for Biology: Presented by the Whitehead family in remembrance of Dr Roger Whitehead, former member of the Common Room. For independent pursuit of knowledge beyond the curriculum.

The Price Cup for Sport: Presented in 2001 by Christopher Price OB. Awarded to a pupil who is pre-eminent in one or more of the traditional Blundell's sports.

Girls' Cup for Sport: Presented in 2007 by Charlotte Vantreen OB. Awarded for excellence in and contribution to Girls' Sport at Blundell's.

Keats Medal: Blundell's oldest prize awarded for rhetoric on chosen biblical and English texts. In memory of Richard Keats, Master, 1775-1797.

Joe Panther Prize: Presented to the Year 11 pupil who has made most academic progress during the year. The legacy of a past member of Common Room, first awarded in 2000.

Blundell's Lodge Salver: Presented for charitable enterprise by Blundell's Lodge, who donate a cheque to the charity of the year.

Way Cup: Awarded as a junior version of the Peter Blundell Prize (see below). In memory of an Old House cleaner, Ken Way, who died aged 40 in the early 1980s; presented by his wife.

The James Galley Memorial Prize: Presented in 2001, in memory of James Galley OB. Awarded to a Blundellian who has shown great determination during their time at the School.

Chairman of Governors' Prize: Started by Admiral Grenier, (who retired as Chairman in 1996), this award is given for contributing to the well-being of the School.

James Bullock Memorial Scholarships Prize: Presented in memory of James Bullock former OB and Governor.

The Head's Prize to a Year 11 Leaver:

Awarded to a pupil in year 11 who is leaving the school and who has made a remarkable contribution to the life of the school or who has shown particular application and determination during their time at Blundell's.

The Randall Thane Prize: Presented by the Governors in 2013 to recognize the contribution made by Randall Thane, Second Master 1997 to 2012 and Head Master Autumn Term 2012. Awarded to a leaver who has positively embraced the opportunities available at Blundell's and made the most of his/her time at the School.

Governors' Leaving Prizes: These acknowledge thoroughly good citizens who have contributed widely to the welfare of the School.

The Head's Award for Community Spirit:

This award is made in recognition to pupils who have contributed wholeheartedly and enthusiastically to various aspects of Blundell's life. Their conduct is marked by humility and community-mindedness.

The Ondaatje Hall Medal: Presented in 1989 by Sir Christopher Ondaatje. This award has particular emphasis on the promotion of international understanding.

Peter Blundell Prize: Awarded for unobtrusive but wholly thorough, reliable and decent contribution to the School by manners, bearing or achievement.

Viscount Amory Prize: Presented by the Governors in 1980 on the retirement of Viscount Amory as Chairman. Awarded for outstanding example of character and personality, often (but not necessarily) in the face of some difficult circumstances.
