SUMMARY OF DUTIES

- To maintain, to a high standard, all the school grounds according to the seasonal requirements
- Cutting and strimming grass to meet the specification for each area
- Hand and mechanical weeding and hedge trimming
- Tidying and collecting waste (including dog waste bins)
- Sweeping and preparing synthetic pitches
- Setting up sports equipment such as tennis nets, goals, flags, stumps and boundaries
- Line marking
- Using both ride-on and pedestrian machines, powered and manual tools including servicing/pre and post use inspection
- To carry out any other tasks reasonably requested by the Head Groundsman or Head Gardener including set up for major school events
- On occasions you may be required to assist other departments to meet the needs of the business
- Complete all necessary training in-house and via Bridgwater and Taunton College to ensure you complete your Qualification in the allotted timescale (normally 2 years using 20% of you working week)
- Comply with all Health & Safety procedures.
- Any other duties as reasonably directed by Head Groundsman
