



## **Boarders Uniform List - Boys**

### **School Uniform**

- 1 x School navy blazer - In Years 12 & 13, worn all year round.  
In Years 7 to 11, worn for Summer term and for match teas, concerts and other school events throughout the year.
- 1 x School tweed blazer - Years 7 to 11 only, worn for Autumn and Spring term.
- 3 x School trousers – dark grey (charcoal)
- 6 x White shirts - long sleeved
- 1 x School tie
- 1 x School navy v-neck jumper (optional)
- 10 x Dark grey socks
- 1 x Smart black leather shoes – appropriate for everyday wear (must have substantial sole)

### **Sports Kit**

- 2 x School tracksuit trousers
- 1 x School waterproof top
- 1 x School fleece or School windproof top
- 2 x School white polo shirts
- 1 x School black games shirt (for training)
- 1 x School black & red striped games shirt (for matches)
- 1 x House games shirt
- 2 x Black rugby style shorts or black PE shorts
- 2 x School black & red games socks
- 4 x Short white sports socks
- 1 x Sports trainers
- 1 x Sports kit bag
- Autumn Term – rugby boots, gumshield
- Spring Term – hockey stick, gumshield, shin pads
- Summer Term - black swimming shorts, swim cap and goggles
- \* From Year 9 some sports are optional.

### **Optional & Team Sports Kit**

- School red and black hoody
- House shorts, vest top & games socks
- School scarf, School cap
- Base layer/thermal long-sleeved top

Some additional sports items maybe used or required, depending on which sports a pupil chooses termly.

- e.g. Tennis – tennis racket, tennis shoes, school white shorts
- Athletics – school athletics vest and running spikes
- Cricket – cricket whites, bat, protection

\*If they are part of the School team, there maybe additional team specific kit required.

### **Home clothes & additional items**

Boarders will need home clothes, which can be worn after school hours and at the weekends. Please bring a selection of clothing, casual, smart and for all weather conditions.

- Trunk or large suitcase (stored on-site during termtime)
- Jumpers/sweatshirts/hoodies
- Trousers/jeans/chinos/shorts/tracksuit
- Shirts/tops/t-shirts
- Underwear & socks
- Nightwear
- Large towels (ideally with hanging loops)
- Duvet
- 2 x Duvet covers (1 to use, 1 to wash)
- Dark coloured coat
- Outdoor shoes
- Wash bag with personal toiletries

Additional Suggestions:

- Weekend bag/case
- Rucksack
- Tuckbox (lockable box to keep valuables in)
- Sportswear & kit
- Dressing gown
- Slippers
- Wellington boots
- Shoe polish kit

Pupils may wish to bring their own radio, speaker, photos, posters to personalise their sleeping area. All laundry is washed on-site, therefore all clothing (home clothes & uniform) need to be clearly name taped and include their house initials after their name. e.g. Jack Hughes P.G.

### **Special Events**

There will be occasions during the year when pupils will need to wear smart home clothes. This is usually chinos, shirt and jacket for the boys.

### **School House pupils (Years 7 & 8)**

Items required for weekend activities throughout the year - weatherproof coat, scarf, gloves, wellington boots and swimming costume.

### **Sixth Formers (Years 12 & 13)**

A dark/sober colour suit with white/light coloured shirt for formal occasions will be needed.
